Research assistants will primarily be involved in an ongoing project in partnership with the NYC Housing Authority (NYCHA) and other academic and practice partners to assess the impact of the smoke-free housing policy compliance supports on the health and well-being of public housing residents.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

- The RAs will be responsible for initial participant contact, baseline and follow-up data collection (questionnaire and salivary samples)
- Role will primarily be field-based; candidate must be comfortable with travel and fieldwork in and around Manhattan and the Bronx. Field work may take place during the day, as well as early evening and weekend hours.
